COMMISSION IMPLEMENTING DECISION

of 8.8.2022

**on the financing of the individual measure for the EU-Korea Green Partnership Action
for 2022**

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THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2018/1046 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 July 2018 on the financial rules applicable to the general budget of the Union, amending Regulations (EU) No 1296/2013, (EU) No 1301/2013, (EU) No 1303/2013, (EU) No 1304/2013, (EU) No 1309/2013, (EU) No 1316/2013, (EU) No 223/2014, (EU) No 283/2014, and Decision No 541/2014/EU and repealing Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 966/2012¹, and in particular Article 110 thereof,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2021/947 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 June 2021 establishing the Neighbourhood, Development and International Cooperation Instrument – Global Europe, amending and repealing Decision No 466/2014/EU and repealing Regulation (EU) 2017/1601 and Council Regulation (EC, Euratom) No 480/2009², and in particular Article 23(3) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) In order to ensure the implementation of the individual measure for the EU-Korea Green Partnership Action for 2022, it is necessary to adopt an annual financing decision, which constitutes the annual work programme, for 2022. Article 110 of Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2018/1046 ('the Financial Regulation') establishes detailed rules on financing decisions.
- (2) The envisaged assistance is to comply with the conditions and procedures set out by the restrictive measures adopted pursuant to Article 215 TFEU³.
- (3) The individual measure provided for in this Decision comprises actions that contribute to climate, clean and just energy transition and biodiversity mainstreaming in line with the European Green Deal and the inter-institutional agreement.
- (4) The Commission has adopted the Multiannual Indicative Programme for the Asia Pacific region for the period 2021-2027⁴. The programme supports the regional priorities and EU interests in full complementarity, coherence and synergy with country and thematic programmes in the following broad areas: Green Deal; digital agenda; sustainable jobs and sustainable growth; migration, forced displacement and mobility; peace and security, governance and rule of law; and multilateralism. programme sets out the following priority areas: regional integration and cooperation; pursuing EU interests with key partners; migration, forced displacement and mobility.

- (5) The objectives pursued by the individual measure to be financed under the Regulation (EU) 2021/947 geographic programme ‘Asia and the Pacific’ are to address global challenges, in particular climate change, the clean and just energy transition, biodiversity, and environmental protection as well as support multilateralism, promote EU values and interests, and support EU trade and investments with key partners in the Republic of Korea. The objectives of this individual measure will be pursued in a direction consistent with the external dimension of the European Green Deal, the Sustainable Development Goals, and the EU’s geopolitical priorities, and in line with the EU Strategy for the Indo-Pacific.
- (6) The action entitled ‘**EU-Korea Green Partnership Action**’ will facilitate and support the operationalisation of the EU-Korea Green Partnership, once adopted. It will aim to support policy dialogues and practical cooperation on shared policy priorities, including accelerating the clean and just energy transition, promoting circular economy approaches, protecting biodiversity and connectivity. The Action will also seek to foster engagement with cities/local authorities, civil society organisations, youth and academia, thereby complementing government-level policy dialogues.
- (7) It is necessary to allow for the payment of interest due for late payment on the basis of Article 116(5) of the Financial Regulation.
- (8) In order to allow for flexibility in the implementation of the individual measure, it is appropriate to allow changes which should not be considered substantial for the purposes of Article 110(5) of the Financial Regulation.
- (9) The measure provided for in this Decision does not fall within the categories of measures for which the prior opinion of the Committee is required. The European Parliament and the Committee established under Article 45 of Regulation (EU) 2021/947 should be informed of this Decision within one month following its adoption,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1
The measure

The annual financing decision, constituting the measure for the implementation of the individual measure for the EU-Korea Green Partnership Action, as set out in the Annex, is adopted.

The measure shall include the following action: ‘EU-Korea Green Partnership Action’.

Article 2
Union contribution

The maximum Union contribution for the implementation of the measure for 2022 is set at EUR 4 000 000, and shall be financed from the appropriations entered in the following line of the general budget of the Union: budget line BGUE-B2022-14.020131.

The appropriations provided for in the first paragraph may also cover interest due for late payment.

Article 3
Flexibility clause

Increases or decreases of up to EUR 10 million not exceeding 20% of the contribution set in the first paragraph of Article 2, or cumulated changes⁵ to the allocations of specific actions not exceeding 20% of that contribution, as well as extensions of the implementation period shall not be considered substantial for the purposes of Article 110(5) of the Financial Regulation (provided that these changes do not significantly affect the nature and objectives of the actions).

The authorising officer responsible may apply the changes referred to in the first paragraph. Those changes shall be applied in accordance with the principles of sound financial management and proportionality.
